2) The practical training will be delivered as follows. The Training & Safety specialist will determine a rotation of training sights to ensure services are offered effectively. We will follow Social distancing as per GOS guidelines. 3) All exams and E-Learn declarations will be managed at the practical training.

4) Employee coming for practical training must bring all required PPE.

Note: (If the E-learning has not been completed prior to attending the practical training, the employee will be sent home.)

The following essential practical training includes:

- Powered Mobile Equipment (PME);
- Loader;
- Truck 2;
- Load Securement;
- Tractor;
- Compaction;
- Flag Person Competency and Truck 1/CVA Check list completed at the section by supervisor or competent person.

5) A Training & Safety specialist will complete the training at the district.

6) Before someone is sent out to train, it **WILL** be confirmed that no one from the area has been out of country in the last 14 days, has not been in contact with someone that has COVID-19 in the last 14 days and that they are healthy. **If an individual attending training is unwell or appears unwell; in consultation with their direct supervisor, they will not be able to attend the practical training and will be rescheduled.**

7) We will be utilizing the Disinfecting Equipment SOP, as well as following all recommendations from health authorities.
