1. What are the barriers to safety?
2. How do we make hazards visible?
3. How do we ensure our work methods are safe?
4. How do we ensure your safety ideas are heard?
5. How do we ensure hazards are quickly corrected?
6. How do we eliminate slip/trip/fall injuries?
7. How do we eliminate overexertion/strain injuries?
8. How do we eliminate contact/pinch injuries?
9. How do we eliminate backing up incidents?
10. How do we eliminate overhead line contact incidents?
11. What Safety Awareness Events/Presentations are needed?

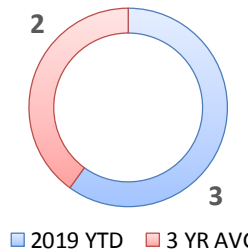

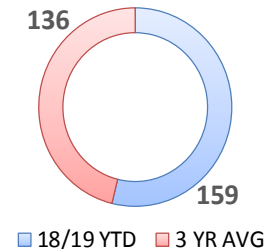

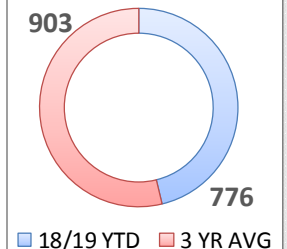
WCB Claims 2019



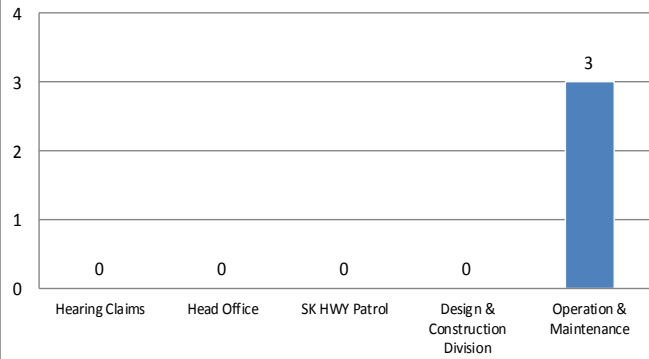
P&E 18/19

WCB Claims - 2019 YTD



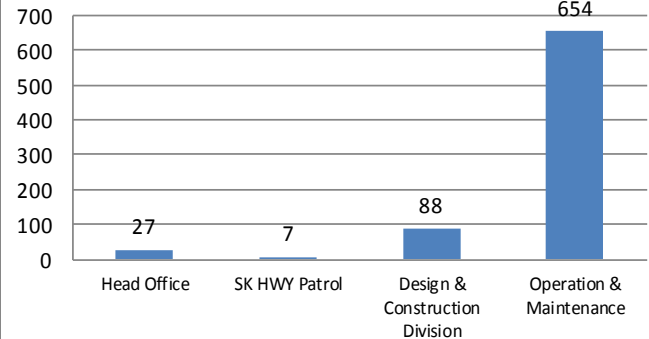
Path to Zero Injuries

Prevention is the key...

1. Safety above all else.
2. Plan your activities and follow the plan.
3. Use "Take 10" to identify hazards and have controls in place prior to starting task.
4. Take the time necessary to complete the job safely and ask for help if needed.
5. Look out for yourself and others.

Complete a hazard assessment prior to starting a task.

Path to Zero Lost Time

1. Injury Prevention
2. Injury Accommodation

The goal is to return employees to work during the recovery period as soon as possible to their regular or modified duties.

Accommodated work is available for most injuries.

Path to Zero P&E Incidents

Prevention is the key...

Focus on backing up and contact incidents.

- Complete a walk around your unit before moving.
- Use a spotter as needed.
- Ensure overhead doors are fully open.
- Ensure box is down
- Ensure overhead line clearance is appropriate.

Preventive Maintenance will reduce unplanned equipment failures.

Dangerous Occurrence P&E – 2

D Unit hit train tracks and D Unit hit electrical box in shop

WCB – lost time claims – 3 employees still off work

Private vehicle hit snow plow

Employee injured shoulder falling off ladder working on loader

Employee injured shoulder falling off ladder replacing a sign

WCB – no lost time claims – 1

Employee broke bone in wrist falling over broom hauling in garbage

Injury 1st Aid – 3

Pinched/cut finger loading hydra-drums

Bed bug bites in hotel

Slip on ice carrying pylons

Preventable P&E Incidents – 31

3 D Unit's hit the bridge; damage to the wing

5 D Unit's hit the building; 3 damaged shop door, 1 damaged rotary lights; 1 damaged side of shop

D Unit hit salt pile damaging fender

Insulation caught fire on D Unit

Bolt on toe of wing came off D Unit

Straps broke off tornado slip on D Unit, damage to wing

D Unit hit post at shop

D Unit ran into meridian; damage to bolt

D Unit was sucked into the ditch, damage to battery box and air tanks

D Unit hit the ditch, plow damage

Wore blades on D Unit, damaging frog

D Unit hooked metal edging at the scale, no damage to D Unit

D Unit hit rock, damage to front wing frame

Top arm that attaches heel of wing plate broke on D Unit

Private vehicle hit CVA, damage to bumper

Box cover lifted off CVA box while driving

CVA window damage being passed by semi

Grader was sucked into the ditch, damage

Grader clipped tree branch, damage to head light

Glass damage to grader, unknown how glass was damaged

Loader hit grader blades buried in the snow; damage to CVA

Private vehicle hit snow plow

Pavement Marking striper damaged when metal bin was moved

Tractor door blew open in transport; damage to glass in door

Unpreventable P&E Incidents – 5

2 tire incidents on D Unit's

Drive shaft broke on D Unit while driving

CVA was hit by ice falling from semi, damage to driver mirror

CVA back window shattered; passing semi through a rock

Near Miss No Injury – 2

Public entered office, was escorted out by Sk Highway Patrol

Equipment was started without notifying employee that was working on it

Near Miss No P&E – 1

CVA hit the ditch, was pulled out by tow truck, no damage

Theft – 2

Steamer trailer was stolen

Office was broken into, fuel card and CVA were stolen

Vandalism – 1

Money and product stolen from washroom

Late reporting – 4 P&E Preventable

MHI staff hit private vehicle with CVA, minimal damage

Plow blades fell on air hose

D Unit hit building, damage to door and flashing

Plow on D Unit hooked a rock and pulled frame apart
