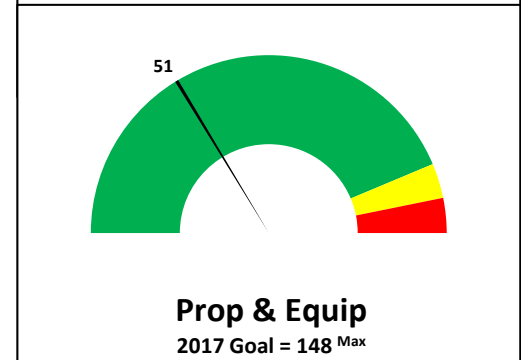
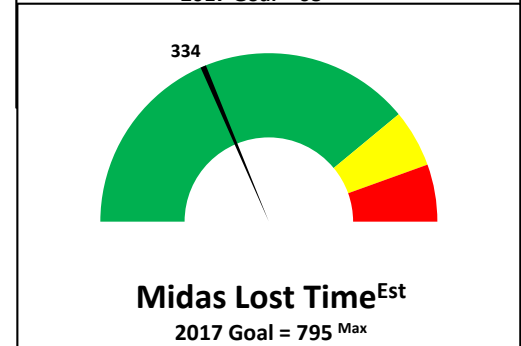
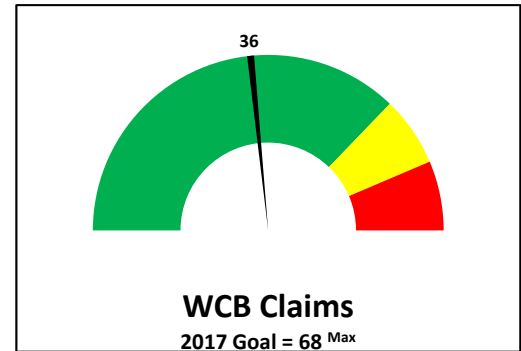

Injury Summary

7 Injury First Aid

6 WCB with 2 lost time totaling 7 days

- cut hand while moving photocopier
- squished hand between two pieces of metal
- hit shin when pounding in work zone sign stub
- blood vessels in right eye broke when air hose hit eye
- hip popped when walking up deck of trailer
- elbow lost mobility from constant exertion
- tripped bruising ear and elbow when moving barricade
- pain in lower back while lifting axle off the floor from the grader
- slipped off mold board of grader injuring ankle
- employee wasn't feeling good at work and went to the doctor
- single vehicle roll over with two employees in the vehicle
- twisted knee climbing off grader fender
- hearing loss claims received

3 Near Miss – No Injury

- employee was stuck in an elevator at Vic Towers
- flagger nudged by vehicle in work zone
- vehicle pulled out of stockpile without stopping

P&E Summary

15 P&E Incidents

- top hinge broke on back panel on sign truck
- wind caught driver side door of CVA
- wind over extended door of CVA damaging quarter panel
- CVA swerved to miss moose and slid into trees and rocks
- CVA hit key pad when entering the yard
- CVA hit rut in farm yard when turning around damaging front end
- CVA damage to bumper/grill
- re-cap tire blew on D Unit
- D Unit knocked light standard in yard down; air brakes were not set
- D Unit turned in approach; damage to spinner mounting bracket
- D Unit clipped pulley on box cover when loading gravel
- D Unit backed into CVA
- right front window on loader broke
- semi; hit and run knocked light post down at the Marshall scale
- tractor sweeper caught gate and cracked post

4 vandalism incidents

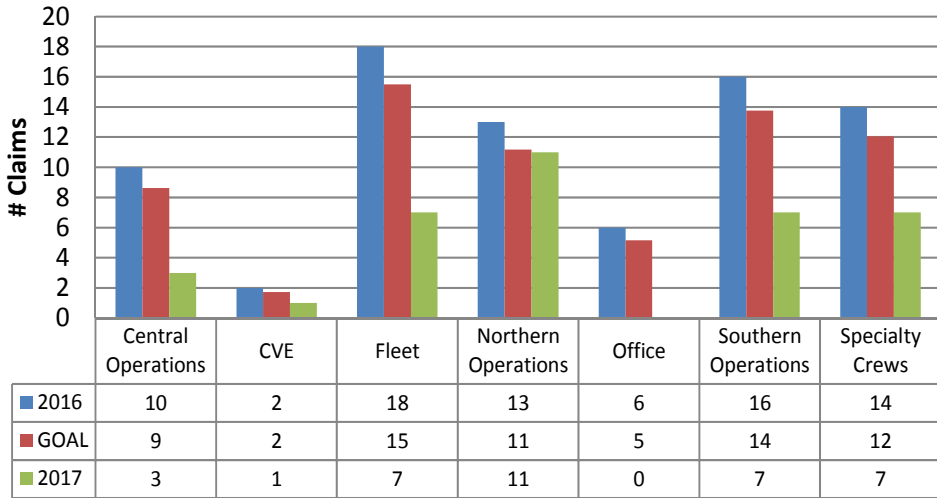
- passenger side tail light was broken on CVA
- attempted theft of equipment in farmers field; damaged, hot wired and moved
- grader damaged; fuel missing
- pylons driven over and arrow board was driven into

2 Near Miss – No P&E

- jack stand broke
- public complaint when passing CVA backing on shoulder of highway

Goal = 68 Claims ^{Max}

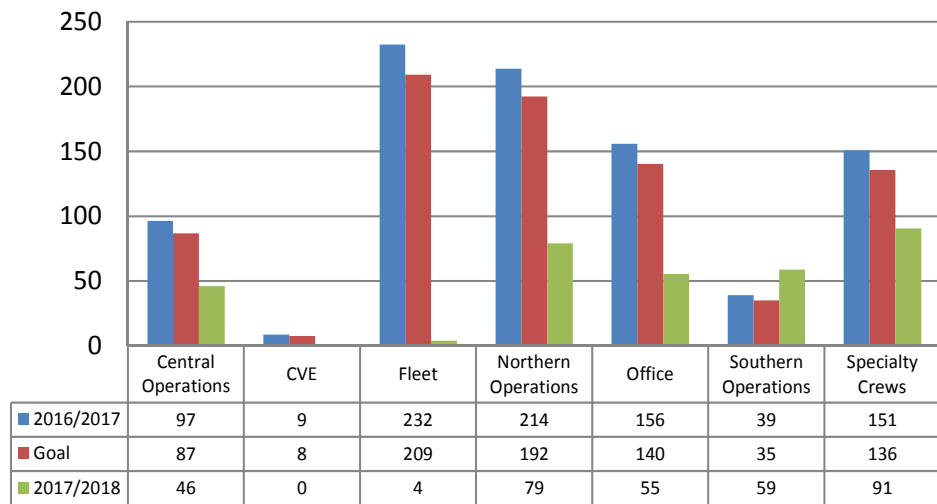
YTD = 36 Claims

WCB claims year to date drives home the importance of identifying potential hazards BEFORE starting a task. Identifying hazards up front such as slippery surfaces, uneven ground, pinch points, sharp surfaces, awkward loads, etc., will significantly reduce preventable injury's.

YTD = 334 Days ^{est}

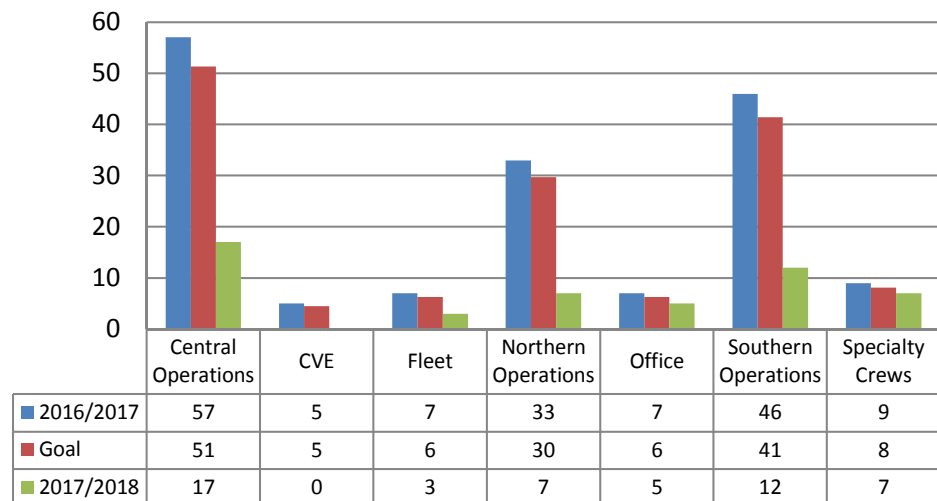
Projection = 1002 Days

When an injury results in medically supported time away from work case management must occur daily. The goal is to return our employees to work during the recovery period as soon as possible.

Accommodated work is available for all injury's.

P&E Incidents



Goal = 148 Incidents ^{Max}

YTD = 51 Incidents
(4 out of 12 months)

Projection = 153 Incidents

Status = **Watch**

Eliminating backing up and contact incidents will ensure the goal is met by fiscal year end. Complete a walk around your unit before moving, use a spotter as needed and ensure overhead doors are open/closed as necessary.

Preventive maintenance will reduce unplanned equipment failures.

Finally, don't blame the wind – plan for it!
